

RESOLUTION NO. 114-25

RESOLUTION OF THE MONROE MUNICIPAL UTILITIES
AUTHORITY (MMUA) AUTHORIZING THE MMUA TO ENTER INTO A
SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE
TOWNSHIP OF MONROE, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, the Township of Monroe ("Township") and Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority ("MMUA") desire to enter into a shared services agreement for the purpose of installing a concrete slab to support the fitness court at Earl E. Owens Memorial Park, a project for which the Township of Monroe has received a partial grant; and

WHEREAS, the MMUA is empowered to enter into contracts and agreements pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 et seq; and

WHEREAS, the shared services agreement has been reviewed and found to be acceptable by both the MMUA and the Township; and

WHEREAS, the MMUA has the staff and skilled labor capable of performing such work in accordance with approved specifications.

WHEREAS, the Township does not have the in-house skilled labor to prepare, install and finish the concrete slab to the required specifications.

WHEREAS, the Township shall be responsible only for the cost of necessary materials for the installation of the concrete slab, subject to appropriation, and shall provide support staff or equipment only if mutually agreed and authorized in advance; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Township to enter in this Shared Services Agreement with the MUA to complete this component of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
2. The Chairman of the MMUA is hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached shared services agreement with the Township.
3. This Resolution shall take effect from August 27, 2025, and continue through October 31, 2025.
4. If any part of this Resolution shall be deemed invalid, such parts shall be severed and the invalidity thereby shall not affect the remaining parts of this Resolution.
5. A copy of this Resolution shall be available for public inspection as required by law.
