RESOLUTION PROPOSING RATE SCHEDULE FOR THE GLOUCESTER COUNTY UTILITIES AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Gloucester County Utilities Authority had previously, on November 13, 2024, established a schedule of rates for the services it provides; and,

WHEREAS, the Gloucester County Utilities Authority desires to amend said schedule to provide for increase service charges; and

WHEREAS, the Gloucester County Utilities Authority desires to formalize the new rate schedule and incorporate it into the Fiscal 2026 Annual Operating Budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Gloucester County Utilities Authority, on this 8th day of October 2025, that the changes to the Rate Schedule, as detailed in the attached and incorporated herein by reference, are proposed; said rates will apply to all services rendered on or after January 1, 2025 and will continue to be in force until amended by formal resolution.

LET IT ALSO BE RESOLVED that all other rates and charges of the Authority shall remain the same as previously established; and

That, in accordance with *N.J.S.A.* 40:14B-23, a public hearing is to be held, to hear all concerns or comments about the revised rates, as part of the Authority's regular Board meeting on November 12, 2025, and

That this resolution shall be published pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40:14B-23 in two newspapers of general circulation in the area serviced by the Authority and mailed to the Clerk of each Municipality serviced by the Authority at least 20 days prior to the public hearing; and
