RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MMUA

TO DESIGNATE A PUBLIC AGENCY COMPLIANCE OFFICER IN ACCORDANCE WITH N.J.A.C. 17:27-3.2, AS PER THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF THE TREASURY DIVISION OF CONTRACT COMPLIANCE & EQUAL OPPORTUNITY IN PUBLIC CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-3.2, each public agency shall designate an individual to serve as its Public Agency Compliance Officer or P.A.C.O.

WHEREAS, the P.A.C.O. is the liaison between the Division and the public agency point of contact for all matters concerning implementation and administration of the statue.

WHEREAS, the P.A.C.O. is also responsible for administering contracting procedures pertaining to equal employment opportunity regarding both the Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority and the service providers. The Service provider shall include but shall not be limited to goods and services vendors, professional service vendors and construction contractors. As such, the P.A.C.O. must have the authority to recommend changes to effectively support the implementation of the statue and its regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority will name Wendy Mahoney, its Public Agency Compliance Officer, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-3.2.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution is effective for the period January 1, 2026 to December 31, 2026.
