Request for proposals ("RFP") responses shall be submitted to Wendy Mahoney, Executive Director of the Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority, 372 South Main Street, Williamstown, New Jersey 08094, on or before February 12, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. at which time said responses will be officially opened and read in the office of the Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority. The Proposal packet may be obtained at the Authority Business Office on 372 South Main Street, Williamstown, New Jersey 08094 or via the Authority website at www.monroemuanj.com

1. Notice to Proposers (Public Advertisement)

The Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority (MMUA) is soliciting competitive contracting proposals pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1 to 4.5 for Scrap Metal Collection and Disposal Services, including on-call container placement, pickups, transportation, lawful processing at authorized Class A recycling facilities, certified weight documentation, and revenue-share/rebate remittances to MMUA. MMUA will award a contract to the responsible proposer whose proposal is most advantageous to the Authority, price and other factors considered, in accordance with LPCL competitive contracting requirements.

This solicitation and any addenda will be posted on MMUA's website (Public Notices / Bid Openings). Proposals must be received by the Qualified Purchasing Agent or Executive Director at 372 South Main Street, Williamstown, NJ 08094, by the due date/time stated above. Late proposals will be returned unopened.

2. Purpose & Scope of Work

2.1 Objectives

- Provide containers (roll-off, lugger, or lockable bins) sized to site conditions at MMUA facilities.
- Perform scheduled and on-call pickups of scrap ferrous and non-ferrous metals (e.g., heavy iron/steel, aluminum, copper, brass, stainless, lead) generated from MMUA operations.
- Transport materials to duly authorized Class A recycling centers and/or markets, ensuring chain of custody and regulatory compliance.
- Provide certified scale tickets, net weights by commodity, pricing basis, and monthly rebate remittances to MMUA per the pricing schedule in Section 9.
- Supply annual tonnage reports suitable for MMUA if needed.

2.2 Materials Included / Exclusions

Included: heavy iron/steel; mixed ferrous; non-ferrous (aluminum, copper, brass, stainless); lead-acid batteries (if separately handled with appropriate compliance and documentation); other metals as accepted by the service provider's receiving facility.

Exclusions: hazardous waste; electronic waste (unless separately contracted); municipal solid waste; Class B/C/D recyclables unless expressly authorized.

2.3 Service Locations

Primary MMUA sites (addresses provided in Appendix A). The Authority may add/remove locations during the contract term with written notice.

3. Contract Term

The initial term is a one-year contract, with one (1) optional 12-month extension at MMUA's sole discretion, subject to performance, continued need, lawful appropriation, and governing body approval.

4. Submission Instructions

- Format & Copies: One (1) original and one (1) electronic copy containing: Technical Proposal, Pricing/Revenue Proposal, Required Forms.

5. Pre-Proposal Conference / Site Visit (Optional)

If scheduled by addendum, attendance is recommended to assess logistics, container placement, access, and safety requirements. Questions raised will be answered via written addendum posted online.

6. Minimum Qualifications

- Experience: At least three (3) years performing scrap metal collection and recycling/disposal for public entities or utilities in NJ.
- Facilities & Licensing: Access to or contracts with Class A recycling facilities authorized in NJ; provide permits/licenses or letters of acceptance.
- Staff & Equipment: Adequate fleet (roll-off trucks, luggers), containers, and trained operators to meet pickup timelines.
- Documentation: Ability to produce certified weight tickets and monthly reconciliation statements.
- Financial Stability: Evidence of capacity to remit timely rebates and manage commodity pricing risk.

7. Compliance with NJ Public Procurement Requirements

- Business Registration Certificate (BRC) with NJ Division of Revenue (required prior to award/contract start).
- Ownership Disclosure Statement (per N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2).
- Non-Collusion Affidavit and Proposal Acknowledgement forms.

- Pay-to-Play Compliance: Fair and open or non-fair and open documentation as applicable (N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.13 et seq.).

8. Technical Requirements

- Containers: Vendor will provide lockable containers sized 10–40 yd suitable for metals; MMUA may request counts and placements per site.
- Pickup Response: Routine within 3 business days of request; Urgent/Overflow within 24 hours when designated by MMUA.
- Weighing & Tickets: Each pickup weighed at a certified scale; submit certified scale tickets, commodity breakdowns, and photos (on request).
- Destination & Compliance: Deliver to authorized Class A facilities (or direct mills/scrap markets); no landfilling.
- Supply annual tonnage reports suitable for MMUA if needed.
- Safety & Site Rules: Comply with MMUA safety, PPE, traffic control, and security protocols.

9. Pricing / Revenue Proposal

- Commodity Index Basis: Identify pricing basis (e.g., AMM/FAST or RecycleNet indexes) and adjustment frequency (monthly).
- Rebate Formula: Provide clear formula for ferrous and each non-ferrous commodity.
- Fees & Deductions: Itemize container rental, transport, contamination charges, and minimum pickup weights.
- Example Calculation: Include two sample pickups showing net rebate to MMUA.
- Prompt Payment: Rebates due within 30 days of monthly statement.

10. Insurance & Indemnification

- Insurance: Certificates naming MMUA as Additional Insured—CGL, Auto, Workers' Comp, Umbrella; minimum limits per Appendix B.
- Indemnification: Vendor shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless MMUA to the extent permitted by NJ law.
