

RESOLUTION NO. 25-26

RESOLUTION AWARDING TRAFFIC CONTROL SERVICES

WHEREAS, there exists a need for Traffic Control Services for the Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority provided public notice that it was accepting request for proposals or qualifications to award Traffic Control Services under the Fair and Open Process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Certifying Financial Officer has certified that the funds as stated in this Resolution are available to the Authority pursuant to N.J.A.C.5:30-5.4, per the following:

01-w-613-05-	\$12,000.00
01-s- 613-05	\$18,000.00

Funds will be appropriated when the budget for the subsequent year(s) is approved.

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law N.J.S.A.40A:11-1 et. seq. requires that the resolution authorizing the award of a Contract for Traffic Control Services without competitive bids must be publicly advertised; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Chairman and Board Members of the Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority in the Township of Monroe, in the County of Gloucester as follows:

1. The Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to execute a Traffic Control Service Agreement with GSCRM TRAFFIC CONTROL SERVICES for the Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority commencing February 19, 2026, and ending February 17, 2027; in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.00.
2. This contract is awarded without competitive bidding under the provisions of the New Jersey Local Public Contract Law N.J.S.A. 40A:11.
3. A notification of this contract shall be published in the Courier Post of Cherry Hill, New Jersey within twenty (20) days of its adoption.
