

RESOLUTION 54-26

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A GPS TRACKING SYSTEM UNDER NEW JERSEY STATE CONTRACT #M4014 FOR THE AMOUNT OF \$33,570.00

WHEREAS, the Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12a and N.J.A.C. 5:34-7.29 c , may by resolution and without advertising for bids, purchase any goods or services under the State of New Jersey Cooperative Purchasing Program for any State contracts entered into on behalf of the State by the Division of Purchase and Property in the Department of the Treasury; and

WHEREAS, the Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority has a need to purchase a GPS Tracking System and related software/hardware services to enhance fleet management and public safety operations; and

WHEREAS, the Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority intends to utilize New Jersey State Contract #M4014 (T2776) for the procurement of said GPS tracking system from an authorized vendor, and

WHEREAS, the Certified Financial Officer has certified the availability of funds for this purchase in an amount not exceed \$33,570.00 for the total license cost over 36 months, as required by N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Monroe Municipal Utilities, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Authorization: The Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized to execute a purchase order for the acquisition of a GPS Tracking System and associated services under State Contract #M4014
2. Vendor: The contract is awarded to Samsara, located at 1 De Haro Street, San Francisco, CA 94017
3. Compliance: This award is subject to all terms and conditions of the State Contract, including but not limited to, the submission of a valid New Jersey Business Registration Certificate by the vendor.
4. Effective Date: This resolution shall take effect immediately and remain in force until the completion of the purchase or the expiration of the State Contract, whichever occurs first.
