

RESOLUTION 97-26

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF A SECURITY CAMERA SYSTEM FROM RIVELL THROUGH THE NEW JERSEY LOCAL PUBLIC CONTRACTS LAW AND THE TIPS NATIONAL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING CONTRACT NO. 230105 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$170,728.85

WHEREAS, the Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority has determined that there is a need to purchase, install, and/or upgrade a security camera system for public facilities in order to enhance safety, security, monitoring, and protection of public property; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., permits contracting units to make purchases through properly authorized cooperative purchasing systems, including nationally recognized and competitively awarded cooperative purchasing contracts, when permitted by law and regulation; and

WHEREAS, the applicable cooperative purchasing rules are set forth in N.J.A.C. 5:34-7 et seq., and the Division of Local Government Services provides guidance to local contracting units concerning cooperative purchasing under the Local Public Contracts Law; and

WHEREAS, The Interlocal Purchasing System, commonly known as TIPS, is a national cooperative purchasing system that offers competitively procured contracts for use by eligible public entities; and

WHEREAS, TIPS Contract No. 230105, Technology Solutions Products and Services, includes technology-related products and services and may be used for security camera systems, surveillance equipment, related hardware, software, installation, configuration, maintenance, and support services, subject to the terms and scope of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority desires to utilize TIPS Contract No. 230105 to procure a security camera system from Rivell, an authorized vendor under said cooperative contract, in an amount not to exceed \$170,728.85, subject to the availability and certification of funds; and

WHEREAS, the Certifying Financial Officer shall certify that sufficient funds are available for this procurement;

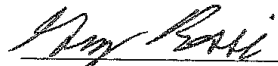
WHEREAS, the Qualified Purchasing Agent has reviewed the proposed procurement and recommends authorization of the purchase through the cooperative purchasing contract in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law and all applicable procurement requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the [Governing Body/Board] of the Monroe Municipal Utilities Authority, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The procurement of a security camera system from Rivell, 900 Hollydell Court, Sewell, NJ 08080 through TIPS Contract No. 230105, Technology Solutions Products and Services, is hereby authorized in an amount not to exceed \$170,728.85.

2. The procurement shall be made in accordance with the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., applicable cooperative purchasing rules, and the terms and conditions of the TIPS cooperative contract.
3. The appropriate officials, including the [Business Administrator/Clerk/Purchasing Agent/Chief Financial Officer], are hereby authorized to execute all documents, issue purchase orders, and take all actions necessary to effectuate this resolution.
4. No contract, purchase order, or expenditure shall be authorized unless and until funds have been certified as available by the Certifying Financial Officer.
5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

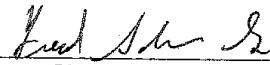
