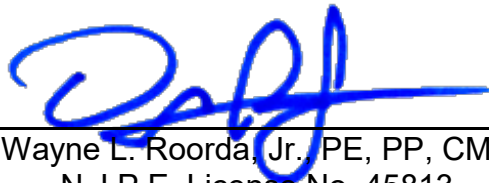

Prospective Bidders and all concerned are hereby informed that the following addendum is made. This Addendum is to be signed by all Prospective Bidders at time of purchase of Bid Documents or otherwise returned to the Borough Engineer via e-mail, facsimile, or hand-delivery.

Acknowledgment of this Addendum No. 1 shall also be recorded within the Bid Documents on the "ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RECEIPT OF CHANGES TO BID DOCUMENT FORM", Page P-3 of the Proposal Section.

All prospective bidders are hereby notified of the following:

The Owner has received inquiries concerning the administration, verification, and enforcement of prevailing wage, certified payroll, apprenticeship, and related labor requirements applicable to the Project.

In response, all bidders are advised as follows:

The Contract is subject to all applicable federal and State labor requirements identified in the Contract Documents, including, without limitation, the New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act, **N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.25 et seq.**, applicable regulations promulgated thereunder, the Public Works Contractor Registration Act, applicable apprenticeship requirements, and the federal labor standards provisions applicable to this federally assisted Project.

The successful Contractor and all subcontractors shall be responsible for full compliance with all such requirements and with the requirements contained in the Contract Documents, including applicable prevailing wage rates, employee classifications, apprenticeship requirements and ratios, certified payroll requirements, fringe benefit requirements, recordkeeping requirements, and the maintenance and production of supporting payroll and employment records.

The Contractor and its subcontractors shall submit all certified payrolls, certifications, apprenticeship documentation, and other labor-compliance documentation required by the Contract Documents and applicable law.

The Owner and/or Engineer will administer the Contract and review required labor-compliance submissions in accordance with the Contract Documents and applicable law. The Owner reserves the right to request and review supporting records and documentation and to undertake such additional verification, inspection, or other compliance measures as may be authorized, appropriate, or required under the Contract Documents or applicable federal or State law.

Contractors and subcontractors shall make records available for inspection, copying, or other review and shall permit access to employees for interviews when required by the Contract Documents or applicable law and when requested by the Owner, Engineer, the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development, the applicable funding agency, or another governmental agency having jurisdiction.

Any suspected or identified noncompliance with applicable prevailing wage, apprenticeship, certified payroll, or other labor requirements may be addressed by the Owner in accordance with the Contract Documents and applicable law, including referral to the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development or other governmental agency having jurisdiction when required or appropriate.

For clarification, to the extent any inquiry references "**N.J.S.A. 12:60**," Title 12:60 is contained in the **New Jersey Administrative Code (N.J.A.C.)**, rather than the New Jersey Statutes Annotated.

Nothing contained in this Addendum shall be construed as modifying, limiting, expanding, or waiving any obligation of the Contractor or any subcontractor under the Contract Documents or applicable federal or

State law, nor shall this Addendum be construed as limiting or expanding the statutory or regulatory authority or responsibility of any governmental agency having jurisdiction.

All other terms and conditions of the Contract Documents, including the Bid Opening Date and Time, remain unchanged.

Prospective Bidder hereby confirms that he or she has received and review this document and all its contents and accepts this information as part of the Contract. Each Bidder should return a copy of this signed addendum via e-mail, facsimile, or hand-delivery and indicate receipt within his or her bid submission.
